The Whitman School of Management at Syracuse University, home to the first supply chain management program in the US started in 1919, is launching an MS in Supply Chain Management starting in fall 2014. This program allows students to complete the program in 9 months, or extend to 16 months when including an internship.

The program is design for students with engineering, science, math, and business backgrounds. Coursework is experiential, allowing students to work on real-world corporate supply chain problems. Courses include Lean Six Sigma, Project Management, and Business Analytics. All international students qualify for merit scholarships in business graduate programs.
